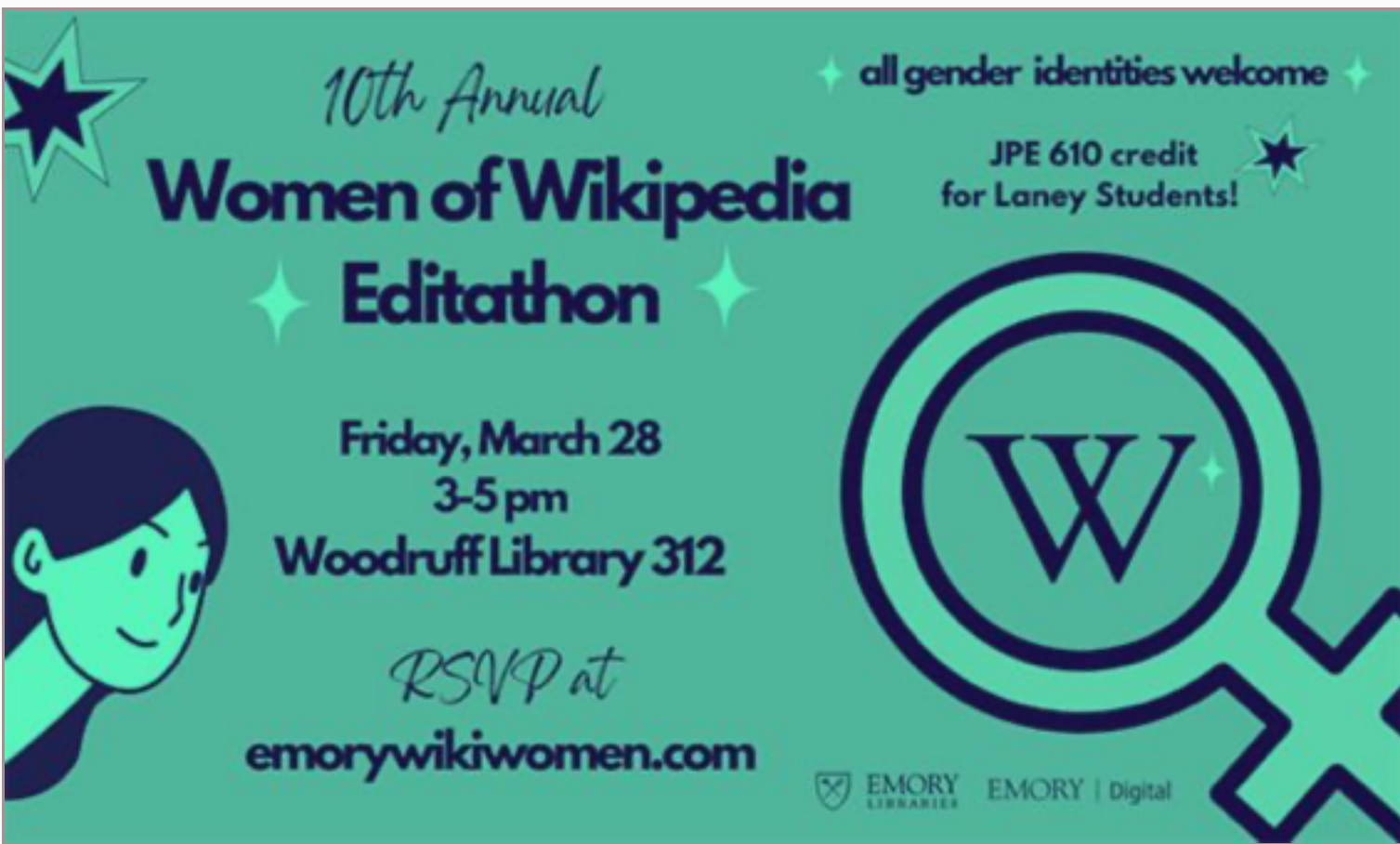
Join us for the Sounding Spirit Festival April 4-5
