
From the Goizueta Business Library's website, click the NYTimes.com database blue button. You will be prompted to authenticate using your Emory NetID/Password.



- 3. If I'm a faculty or staff, when will my registration expire
 - a. Every 52 weeks after your initial registration, you will need to reauthenticate. When you experience hitting the paywall (e.g. articles are "locked"), just click on the registration link, http://pid.emory.edu/tnf55, click "Already have an account? Log in here," and log in with your Emory.edu email and your existing NYTimes password. Your access will resume uninterrupted for another 52 weeks.
