

A profile contains all of the information that PitchBook has researched and obtained for that particular entity. In this tutorial, we'll be taking an in-depth look at the profile of a Company.



• First, let's find a company within the platform that is categorized as a Company. Click Search PitchBook...






The drop-down menu allows us to switch between the different profile types. Right now, we're looking at Facebook as a Public Company, but they also have an Investor profile since they're also considered a Corporate Acquirer.


By default, we'll land on the Profile tab. It contains various data sets that we can navigate through using the Contents sidebar. The other tabs near the top expand on those data sets and let us interact with it in different ways.

The Stock Performance section provides a quick overview on the performance of the company's stock. Stats include Market Cap, EPS, Average Volume, Shares and Beta. There's also a chart that shows the historical closing price of the stock over time.



The Financials section provides a look at the company's historical financials (EV, Revenue, EBITDA, etc.) as reported on their income statement. The Consensus Estimates section displays the projected financial figures for each of the main data points.



The Timeline section covers the company's growth. The dotted line represents their employee count. The vertical bars represent the capital they received from each deal. You can hover to see more information. The example shows details on their IPO.



The General Information section provides a summary of the company. It includes their business description, ownership status, industry classification, and more.



The Equity Research section contains reports sourced from our parent company, Morningstar. These reports summarize and break down information about the specified company, and ultimately provide a recommendation to buy, sell or hold.




The Recent Notes section allows you to add notes about the company or review previously written notes.

The Similar Companies section lists five other similar companies based on their industry and size.



The Stock Price History allows you to take a deeper look into the company's stock price.


The chart is larger and you can change the Zoom settings to view the stock price changes over different time periods.

The Signals section looks at non-financial metrics of a company's growth and size. It incorporates web traffic and social media presence.



The Executives section lists all the current and former members of a company's executive management team. In addition to their name and title, you can access their contact information through the buttons on the right side.



The Board Members & Observers section lists all of the people that sit on the company's board of directors. It gives their name, title, and the name of the company they're representing while on the board.



The Deal History section will list every financing event the company has gone through since being founded. It will cover the deal type, date, deal size amount, and the post valuation as a result of the deal.





This leads us to a section within the profile that displays even more data regarding that single transaction. Next, let's take a look at how we can expand the Deal Details for a more in-depth look.



This Sellers/Exiters section lists all of the investors that sold their shares in the company at the time of the transaction. We can see the firm's name along with their ownership percentage.



The Advisors section lists all of the Service Providers that were hired by the company to help facilitate the deal. We can see the SP's name, the service they provided, and any additional comments.



Now you know how to view a company's entire deal history, as well as diving deeper on a single transaction. Let's pick back up and continue navigating through the other sections found on a company profile. Click Investors



PitchBook Data

The Investors section lists all of the individuals or firms that have ever been involved in a transaction with the company. It displays their name, investor type, and when they became an investor. You can click on their name to visit their profile.



The Lenders on Deals section lists all the lenders and banks that provided debt to the company. It displays the Lender's name, the type of debt, and the deal in which it was received.



The Service Providers section lists all of the firms that were brought in to help facilitate a transaction. It displays the firm's name, the type of service provided, and the deal they were involved in.



The Lead Partners on Deals section lists all of the professionals from any of Facebook's investors that have played a key role in managing and completing a deal. It displays their name, contact information, and the deals they've been apart of.



The Investments section displays all of the deals where the company was the Investor. In this particular example, we can see that Facebook had acquired multiple software companies through M&A deals.



The Affiliates section lists any Parent Companies or Subsidiaries associated with the Investor. In this case, Facebook is the parent company of 22 subsidiaries. You can click any of the subsidiary names to visit their own profile.



The News section will list the most recent articles that mention the company. Clicking on an article will open a new tab and take you to the website that the article was sourced from.











You can use the available tabs to get a more in-depth look at a particular set of financial data. Click Income Statement



In this view, we can see how each financial data point was derived. You can also use the Search Bar found on the left-hand side to search for any particular metric across all of the tabs.










Each of the available templates will contain a different set of data points related to the company. Click Deals


This window lists all of the data points that would be downloaded through this template. This template would export the company's entire deal history including details on every deal such as the deal type, size, valuation, multiples, and more.




